- Public Hearing for Adjudicated Properties – June 20, 2023 @ 5:30 PM

Discussion of proposals for short-term disposal service

- Greenway
- Waste Management

The previous contract was entered into in June of 2013 and is hereby taken notice of the previous minutes. The board reviewed the bids submitted by Greenway and Waste

Management. An invitation for offers was submitted by the city (Exhibit 1). Waste Management submitted a \$37 a ton bid (Exhibit 2) and Greenway submitted a \$46 a ton bid (Exhibit 3). The offer from waster Waste Management was \$37 a ton for the next 2,027 (\$74,999 total) was the lowest and best offer. Miss. Code Ann. § 31-7-13(m)(xxii) exempts bidding formalities for garbage disposal. Miss. Code Ann. §§ 31-7-13 (r) only requires the city to go through a request for proposal process only prior to entering a contract not to exceed \$75,000.

A motion was made by Alderwoman Hall, seconded by Alderwoman Irving to accept the offer of Waste Management for \$37 a ton effective July 1, 2023, for \$74,999 and to authorize attorney to send over a revised contract in the form on the basis of the new rates and not to exceed \$75,000.

The motion carried unanimously.
